
Mr. Kubely,

Observation of the Omni Sphere portable units that your company is building along with supporting documents and backup material indicate that the Omni Spheres meet OSHA Safety Regulation 29 CFR 1910.142 for support units in Temporary Labor Camps.

Temporary labor camps are used for remote and nonpermanent living facilities for employees and must meet minimum standards for employee's health and safety. Temporary labor camps are constructed to house from a few to hundreds of employees. Requirements for considerations with regards to employee safety and health in Temporary labor camp are;

1. Site Location
2. Shelter Requirements
3. Water Supply
4. Toilet facilities
5. Sewage Disposal
6. Laundry, Handwashing & bathing facilities
7. Lighting
8. Refuse Disposal
9. Feeding Facilities if Required
10. Insect & Rodent Control
11. First Aid
