
After reading today MSNBC's article "FEMA Trailers 'Toxic Tin Cans'" I wanted to renew our discussion we have had regarding the 'DOMES' that have been working well here in Los Angeles with the homeless community. As we discussed earlier I believe this system has some utilization as we continue to do our pandemic planning as related to surge capacity around hospitals, at airports, etc.

I did make inquiry with FEMA relative to the acceptability of such units and found no restrictions to using them as temporary shelters and I am committed to following up with the Director of FEMA, Under Secretary Paulison to have additional conversation. I know you are providing these units to the DOD and believe it would be useful to get the two organizations talking and see if we can change the culture as it relates to temporary housing.

As a 32-year career emergency manager we see few opportunities to really make giant leaps in the way we do thing in disaster preparedness. I believe InterShelter is one of those opportunities when we can do some things differently.

I look forward to sitting down discussing future opportunities. Let's continue to try to make a difference and change the culture of preparedness and recovery.
